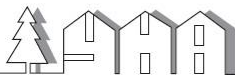
1. Certain facilities may not be available during day camp period. Additional charge applies for the use of multi-purpose rooms.

3. Cancellations*

No cancellation or amendment can be made once the booking is confirmed.

Except for the adverse weather arrangements listed below:

- A. If announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that the Red/Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is hoisted or Typhoon Signal No.3 is likely to be hoisted / hoisted 3 hours prior to camp commencement, guests who make the reservation may change the date once for free. If the aforesaid warning or typhoon signal is lowered or cancelled before 3 hours prior to camp commencement, guests who make the reservation have to arrive at the hostel as scheduled otherwise will be deemed to be a 'no show' and no refunds will be made.
- B. If announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that the Red/Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is hoisted or Typhoon Signal No.3 is likely to be hoisted / hoisted during camping, no refunds will be made.
- C. Concerning the adverse weather arrangements stated above, affected guests must contact the HKYHA reservation center via email (info@yha.org.hk) to confirm the rescheduled check in date within 5 working days after the day which rainstorm warning or typhoon signal was announced by the Hong Kong Observatory.
