

1. Booking Confirmation and Payments

Room reservation will be confirmed instantly and payments are due in full at the time of booking.

2. Check-in

Upon arrival, please check-in at the reception with valid identity document (e.g. passport / Hong Kong ID / travel document), together with valid HKYHA / Hostelling International individual or group membership card and booking confirmation letter.

3. Security Deposit[°]

A security deposit is required upon check-in at hostel receptions and will be collected in either cash or credit card. If the guest does not cause any damages or losses to the hostel during the stay, the deposit will be returned in full upon check out.

4. YHA Membership

YHA individual membership applies to the membership cardholder only, and may not be used by any other 3rd person.

If guests are not a member of Hong Kong Youth Hostel Association (HKYHA) or International Youth Hostel Association (Hostelling International, HI), yet, they may apply the membership online on [our website](#) or upon arrival at hostel reception (only individual membership is available for on-site application). Arrangements are as follows:

YHA Mei Ho House Youth Hostel	Guests who make the reservation with member rate must be a HKYHA or HI member. If guests fail to present a valid membership card upon check-in, they must apply the membership instantly or pay the price difference between the member and non-member rates at hostel reception.

Each Private Room / Private Dormitory / Bell Tent / Tent should provide at least one valid membership card during check in.

+Under latest government policy, the number of staying guests for each Room, Private Dormitory, Tent, Bell Tent or Tent of Bring Your Own Tent should not be more than 4 people. For any cases of violation, the hostel will immediately terminate the stay of the guests without any refund. If the hostel suffers any losses or receives any fines from authorised authority as a result, Hong Kong Youth Hostels Association (HKYHA) and the hostel shall reserve the right to claim compensation from the guests.

6. Cancellation Policy[#]

No cancellation or amendment can be made once the booking is confirmed⁺. For other booking enquiries, please contact our reservation center directly via email (info@yha.org.hk). If guests do not arrive the hostel on the scheduled date of arrival, no refund will be made. If their bookings are more than one night, hostel will reserve the right to cancel their remaining booking and resell the accommodation.

9. Additional Charges

All guests must not exceed the maximum specified occupancy[^] of the reserved room type. If additional beds are needed, please contact our reservation center in advance to check the availability and make corresponding reservation.

[^]If the actual number of guests staying are more than the maximum specified occupancy of the reserved room type, the hostel will charge the guests for the extra bed or reject the staying of the exceeded number of guests.

10. Luggage Allowance

If announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that the Red / Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is hoisted or Typhoon Signal No.3 or higher Storm Signal is likely to be hoisted between 12noon and 11pm on the check-in date, guests who make the reservation may change the staying date once for free. If the aforesaid warning or typhoon signal is lowered or cancelled before 12noon on the check-in date, guests who make the reservation have to check in as scheduled, otherwise they will be deemed as “no show” and no refunds will be made.</p> <p>B. If announcement is made by the Hong Kong Observatory that the Red / Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is hoisted or Typhoon Signal No.3 is likely to be hoisted during the stay. In house guests may choose to leave the hostel before it closes by informing the hostel staff; guests may change the staying date of those remaining nights once for free while the stayed nights will not be counted and are non-refundable. If guests decide to stay in the hostel, no refunds will be made.</p> <p>C. Concerning the adverse weather arrangements stated above, affected guests must contact our reservation center via email (info@yha.org.hk) to confirm the rescheduled check-in date within 5 working days from the day which rainstorm warning or typhoon signal was announced by the Hong Kong Observatory. The new check-in date must be within three months from the original check-in date. If the price of accommodation on rescheduled date(s) is higher than the original price, guests are required to pay the difference. If the price of accommodation on the rescheduled date(s) is lower than the original price, no refunds will be made.</p>
